Fall/Winter (September Entry)

The document deadlines for most UAlberta programs are:

High school applicants: Some document(s) may be required with your application or by March 15. See which deadline applies to you at www.studyincanada.ualberta.ca/documents.

Final results of your current year are required by August 1.

Post-secondary/transfer applicants: Some document(s) will be required with your application or by March 15. See which deadline applies to you at www.studyincanada.ualberta.ca/documents.

Final results of your current year are required by June 15.
